(herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:

Parcel 2: Part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, Township 21 South, Range 4 West, Shelby County, Alabama, said part being more particularly described as follows: From the northwest corner of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ run south along the west line of said $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{4}$ section for a distance of 189.73 feet to the point of beginning, thence turn an angle to the left of 89 deg. 22' and run east for a distance of 1265.66 feet to the west line of a public road, thence turn an angle to the right of 78 deg. 23' and run southeasterly along the west line of said road right of way for a distance of 193.79 feet, thence turn an angle to the right of 101 deg. 38' and run westerly for a distance of 1302.58 feet to a point on the west line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, thence run north along said west line for 189.74 feet to the point of beginning.
