Whereas David Brewster of Shelby County, Kentucky, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Washington, D.C., whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said David Brewster according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1830, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the tract half of north east quarter Section twenty three in Township Eighteen of Range six West in the District of West Virginia and State of a State and containing seventy three acres and thirty hundredths of an acre

892 according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said David Brewster

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said David Brewster and his heirs the said tract above described. To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said David Brewster and his heirs and assigns forever.
