whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Abner A. and John E. Hughes,

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the South-west quarter of Section twenty-one, in Township twenty-one, of Range one, East, in the district of lands offered for sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing eighty acres, and five hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Abner A. and John E. Hughes.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted; and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Abner A. and John E. Hughes and to their heirs, the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereto belonging, unto the said Abner A. and John E. Hughes, heirs and assigns forever, as tenants in common, and not as joint tenants.
