(hereinafter called "Grantee"), the following described

real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to wit:

Begin at the Southeast corner of Section 18, Township 21 South, Range 2 West, and run northerly along the East boundary of said Section a distance of 3.96 feet to the point of beginning of the tract of land herein described. From said point of beginning, continue northerly along the East boundary of said Section a distance of 745.95 feet to a point; thence turn an angle of 121° 03' to the left and run southwesterly a distance of 355.41 feet to a point on the northeasterly right of way line of the L & N Railroad; thence turn an angle of 82° 54' to the left and run southeasterly along said right of way line a distance of 410.21 feet to a point; thence turn an angle of 90° to the left and run northeasterly a distance of 50 feet to a point; thence turn an angle of 90° to the right and run southeasterly along said right of way line a distance of 227.58 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.7 acres, more or less.

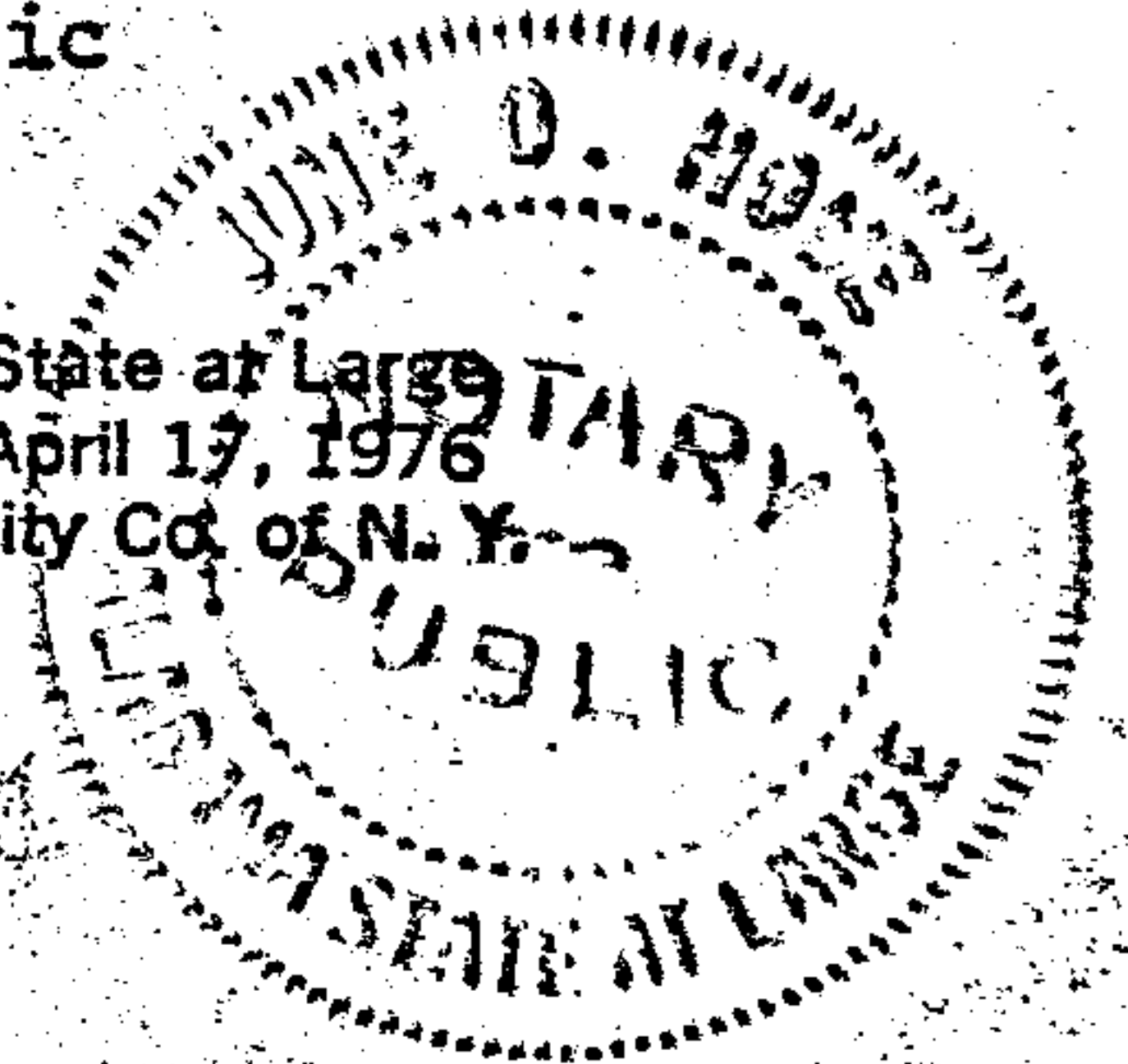
