(herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto

(herein referred to as GRANTEEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:

Commencing at the SW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2, Township 24 North, Range 12 East; thence run North along the West line of said  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section a distance of 2408.0 feet to the center line of Highway 25; thence turn an angle of 96 deg. 34 min. to the right and run along center line of said highway a distance of 274.35 feet; thence turn an angle of 96 deg. 55 min. to the left and run along the East margin of a gravel road a distance of 597.20 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue in the same direction along the East margin of the gravel road a distance of 105 feet; thence turn an angle of 94 deg. 28 min. to the right and run a distance of 200 feet; thence turn an angle of 85 deg. 32 min. to the right and run a distance of 105 feet; thence turn an angle of 94 deg. 28 min. to the right and run a distance of 200 feet to the point of beginning.
