

RESOLUTION OF ADDITION TO THE SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY
RESOLUTION ON 11-1-61 BY THE LEEDS CITY PLANNING COMMISSION

Under the authority of Title 37, Article 3, Section 797-803,
inclusive, of the 1940 Code of Alabama (Recompiled 1958), which were
made a part of the Subdivision Regulations by resolution of the Leeds
City Planning Commission on 11-1-61 at a regular meeting of the
Commission, The Leeds City Planning Commission, after due and proper
notice being given, at its regular meeting on November 21, 1977,
adopted by resolution the following addition to the Subdivision
Regulations of the City of Leeds, Alabama:

BE IT RESOLVED that the following section be added to the
Subdivision Regulations of the City of Leeds, to-wit:

SECTION 29 FIRE HYDRANTS

Fire Hydrants shall be required for all subdivisions and they
shall be located no more than eight hundred (800) feet apart and
within four hundred (400) feet of any structure and shall be approved
by the Fire Protection Unit. To eliminate future street openings,
all underground utilities for fire hydrants, together with the fire
hydrants themselves and all other supply improvements shall be installed
before any final paving of the streets shown on the subdivision plat.

This resolution shall be effective this the 21st day of November,
1977, and the secretary shall certify a true and correct copy hereof to
the City Clerk of the City of Leeds and to the Probate Judges of Jeff-
erson, Shelby and St. Clair Counties.
