Overstreet and Henry Ella Overstreet, their heirs and assigns, a right-of-way hereinafter described over and across our land in Shelby County, Alabama, for the means of ingress and egress over and along the right-of-way herein conveyed, being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the NW corner of SE% of NE%, Section 11, Township 24 North, Range 12 East, thence south along the west line of said 1/4 a distance of 390.82 feet to point of beginning; thence continue along said west line a distance of 20 feet to a point; thence west a distance of 41 feet to east R.O.W. line of Shelby County Road 200; thence north along east R.O.W. a distance of 20 feet to a point; thence east a distance of 41 feet to the point of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said Charles E. Overstreet and Henry Ella Overstreet, their heirs and assigns, to said parcel of land for roadway purposes only.
