WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR LIFE WITH REMAINDER TO SURVIVOR

Shelby County

Know All Men By These Presents,

That in consideration of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars and other
good and valuable consideration

to the undersigned grantor or grantors in hand paid by the
GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged we,
Margaret W. Murphy, William W. Murphy and wife, Margaret B.
Murphy, being the heirs and next of kin of William H. Murphy,
deceased, and James C. Murphy, Jr., and wife, Iva E. Murphy,
(herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and
convey unto: James C. Murphy Jr., and wife, Iva E. Murphy
(herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint
lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor
of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder
and right of reversion, the following described real estate
situated in Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:

Lot numbered 5 according to the Map and survey of Murphy's
Fishing Camp located in the E1/2 of the SE1/4 of Section
2, Township 24, Range 15 East, Shelby County, Alabama,
said map being recorded in Map Book 3, Page 72, in said
Probate Office.

To Have and To Hold, to the said GRANTEES for and during their
joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the
survivor of them in fee simple, and to the heirs and assigns of
such survivor forever, together with every contingent remainder
and right of reversion.

assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said
premises; that they are free from all encumbrances:
