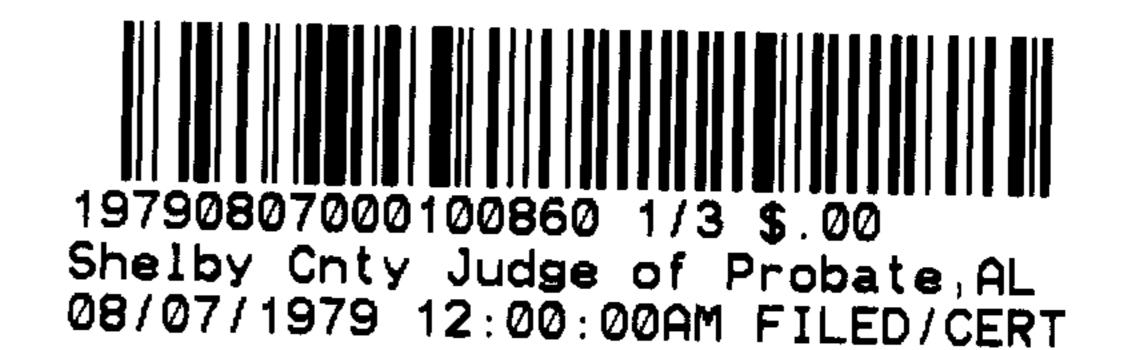

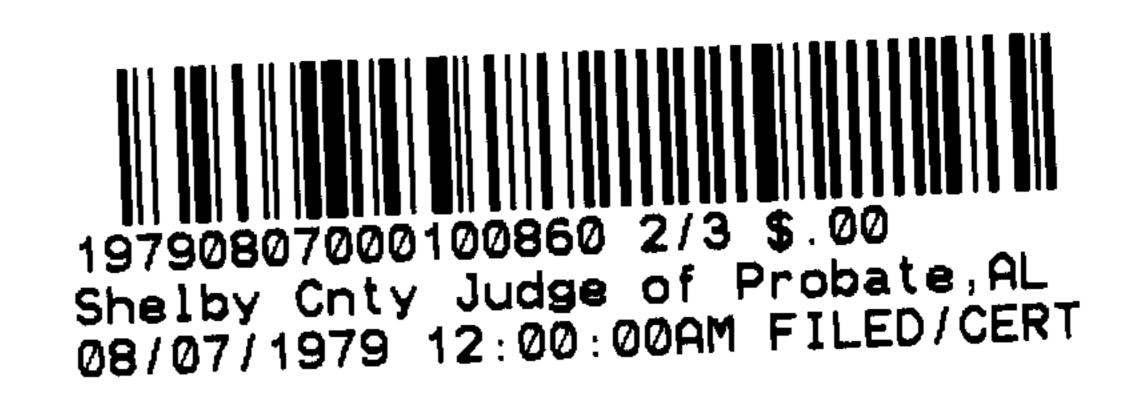
FORECLOSURE DEED
