

## AFFIDAVIT

My name is Johnnie Jones Hill. My mother was Annie Velma McClanahan Jones, and my father's name was Warren F. Jones. I am not quite as familiar with my family's history as my aunt, Alberta McClanahan Williams; however, I have read her affidavit which is attached hereto and made a part of this affidavit, and the facts set forth therein are true according to the best of my knowledge, information and belief.

This affidavit, as well as the affidavit of my aunt which is attached hereto, is made for the purpose of clearing up the title of the property that was purchased by my great grandmother, Mary Wallace, under two deeds; one being recorded under "Deed Records Book 4, Probate Court of Jefferson County, Alabama, at Page 295, covering "two acres, more or less", and the other deed being recorded at "Deed Book 10, Page 498, Probate Court of Shelby County", covering the sale of approximately 35 acres. This property being more particularly described as follows:

A tract of land located in the North Half of the Northeast Quarter and the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 22 South, Range 1 West, Shelby County, Alabama and being more particularly described as commencing at the Northeast corner of said Section 1; thence South 20 11' West along the East line of said Section 1, 666.9 feet to the place of beginning; thence from the place of beginning South 00 42' West 496.1 feet; thence South 87° 33' West 2117.0 feet; thence South 870 28' West 246.5 feet to the Easterly right of way line of Shelby County Highway No. 47; thence along the Easterly right of way line of said highway and around a curve to the right, the chord bearing and distance of North 330 15' West 276.3 feet to a point of tangency; thence continuing along the Easterly right of way of said highway, North 30 37' West 501.0 feet; thence North 850 05' East 648.9 feet; thence South 860 46' East 2130.5 feet to the place of beginning and containing 35.5 acres more or less.
