The acceptance of the above and foregoing dedication shall not be construed in any way whatsoever to approve the use of said road to any subdivision or other development adjacent thereto or served thereby, and in addition, any person, firm or corporation developing any property in the future either adjacent to or served by the above said read, whether a subdivision or otherwise, will be required to meet all requirements of Shelby County Subdivision Regulations or other requirements of Shelby County in connection therewith in connection with the upgrading of the above road, additional rights-of-way or improvements of either, all at the expense of such person, firm or corporation so developing or planning such development.
