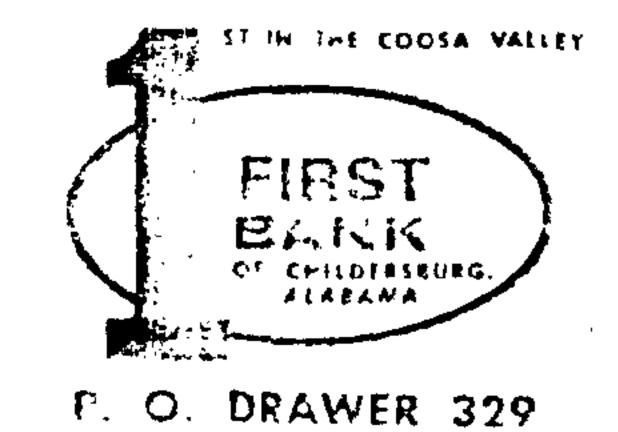

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into on this, the <u>26th</u> day of January 1981by and between

WITNESSETH: That, WHEREAS, the said James N. Wood and Gail B. Wood

35 installments of \$133.00 and 1 installment of 110.03.
These installments shall begin on March 10, 1981.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of said indebtedness and any other indebtedness arising hereunder and in order to secure the same, and any other indebtedness now or hereafter owing to the Mortgagee by said Mortgagor, the Mortgagor does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Mortgagee the following described property, to-wit:

From the SE corner of the NE% of the SW%, Section 21, Township 19, South, Range 2 Ease, Run West along the South boundary of said 1/4 a distance of 141.12 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue in a straight line a distance of 210.00 feet; thence right 91 degrees 57 minutes a distance of 210.00 feet; thence right 88 degrees of minutes a distanc of 210.00 feet; thence right 91 degrees 57 minutes a distance of 210.00 feet to the point of beginning. Situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

TO HAVE AND 10 hOLD, ingether with all and singular the rights, tenements, hereaficaments, and apparamentas thereunto belonging of in anywise appertaining, unto the Mortgagee, and the Mortgagee's successors and estimus, in fee simple.

And the Mortgagor does hereby covenant with the Mortgages that the Mortgagor is lawfully salzed in the of said premises; that the Mortgagor has a good right to sell and convey the same; that said premises are free from incurriprance; and that the Mortgagor warrants, and will forever defend the title to said premises against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.

This conveyance is upon condition, however, that, if the Mortgagor shall may and discharge the indebtedness hereby secured as the same matures and shall perform the covenants herein contained, then this conveyance shall become null and void. But if the said Mortgagor should make default in the payment of any part of the indebtedness hereby secured or in the payment of the interest thereon, or should fail to keep any covenant in this mortgage contained, or should be adjudicated bankrupt, or if the improvements on said premises are damaged so as to make the insurance thereon or any part of said insurance payable, then, in the election of the Mortgagee, the entire indebtedness secured hereby shall become immediately due and payable, and failure to declare the entire indebtedness due in case of default shall not operate as a waiver of the right to declare the entire indebtedness due in the event of any subsequent default; and the Mortgagee, the Mortgagee's agent or attorney, is hereby authorized to take possession of the property hereby conveyed, and with or without possession thereof to sell said property at public outcry to the highest bioder, for cash, before the south door of the court house of Talladega County, Alabama, after giving notice of the time, place, and terms of sale by publication once a week for three successive weeks in some newspaper published in said County or by posting notice at three public places in said County.

In case of sale under the power herein contained, the Mortgagee or any person authorized in writing by the Mortgagee shall have power to execute a conveyance to the purchaser, conveying all the right, title, interest, and claim of the Mortgagor in and to said premises, either at law or in equity. The Mortgagee may purchase said property at any sale becaunder and acquire title thereto as could a stranger.

Out of the proceeds of sale the Mortgagee shall pay, first, the costs of advertising, selling, and conveying said property, together with a reasonable attorney's fee; secondly, the amount of the indebtedness due and owing to the Mortgagee hereby secured, together with the interest thereon, and any taxes, insurance premiums, or other charges that the Mortgagee may have paid as herein provided; and lastly, the surplus, if any, shall be paid to the Mortgagor, or the Mortgagor's hairs or assigns.

The Mortgagor covenants that the Mortgagor will pay all taxes and assessments which may lawfully be levized against the premises, and will deposit receipts therefor with the Mortgagee, and that the Mortgagor will insure, and keep insured the improvements thereon against loss by fire and tornado for not less than the indebtedness hereby secured, in some company acceptable to the Mortgagee, with loss payable to the Mortgagee as the Mortgagee's interest may appear, and will deposit with the Mortgagee the policies evidencing such insurance, and that the Mortgagor will protect said premises from wasta and keep the same in good condition and repair; and in case of the failure of the Mortgagor to pay said taxes or assessments before the same, or any part thereof, become delinquent, or in case of failure to insure or keep insured in said amount the improvements on said property, or in case of failure to protect said premises from waste and keep line same in good condition and repair, the Mortgagee may, at the Mortgagee's option, either pay said taxes and assessments and purchase said insurance and protect said premises from waste and keep same in good condition and repair, or any of them and the amount of taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, repairs, and other expenditures, or any of them, as paid shall be secured by this conveyance as fully and to the same extent and under the same conditions as the indebtedness hereinabove described - or the Mortgagee may, at the Mortgagee's election, proceed to forclose this mortgage, as is hereinabove provided.

Mortgagor agrees and stipulates that as against the collection of this said indebtedness the said Mortgagor does hereby waive all right of exemptions, both as to homestead and personal property, under the consitution and laws of the State of Alabama, or of any other state, or of the United States.
