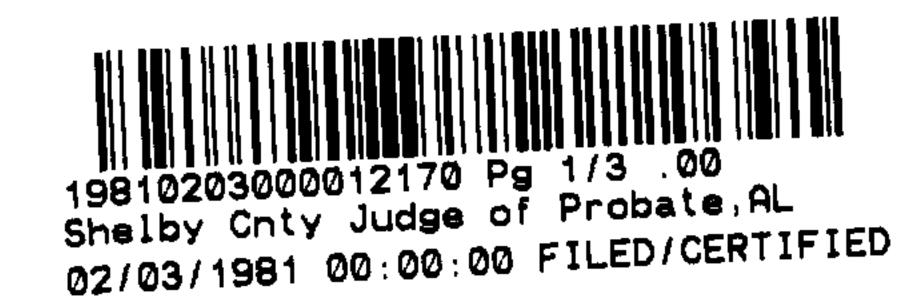

The Mortgagee may collect a "late charge" not to exceed hom cents. If the total of the payments made by the Mortgagor under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding shall exceed the amount of the payments actually made by the Mortgagee for ground rents, taxos, assessments and insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess, if the loan is current, at the option of the Mortgagor, shall be credited on the subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, or refunded to the Mortgagor. If, however, the monthly payments made by the Mortgagor under (1) of paragraph 2 preceding shall not be sufficient to pay ground rents, takes, assessments, and insurance premiums, as the case may be, when the same shall become due and payable, than the Mortgagor will pay to the Mortgagee any amount necessary to make up the deficiency, on or before the date when payment of such ground rents, taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums shall be due. That he will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property, insured as many be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and other hazards, casualties and contingencies in such amounts and for such periods as may be required by the Mortgagee and will pay promptly, when due, any premiums on such insurance provision for payment of which has not been made hereinbefore. All insurance shall be carried in companies approved by the Mortgagee and the policies and termewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee. In event of loss Mortgagor will give immediate notice by mail to the Mortgagee, who may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Mortgagor, and each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to the Moragages instead of to the Mortgagor and the Mortgagee jointly, and the insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, may be applied by the Mortgagee at its option either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured or to the restoration or repair of the property damaged. In examination exclusions sure of this mortgage or other transfer of title to the mortgaged property in extinguishment of the indebtedness secured hereby, all right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser or grantee.

8. If the Mortgagor fails to insure said property as hereinabove provided, or to pay all or any part of the taxes or assessments levied. accrued, or assessed upon or against said property or the indebtedness secured hereby, or any interest of the Mortgagee in either, or fails to pay immediately and discharge any and all liens, debts, and/or charges which might become liens superior to the fiem of this mostgage, the Mortgagee may, at its option, insure said property and/or pay said taxes, assessments, debts, liens, and/or charges, and any momey which the Mortgagee shall have so paid or become obligated to pay shall constitute a debt to the Mortgagee additional to the debt beneby specially secured, shall be secured by this mortgage, shall bear legal interest from date paid or incurred, and, at the option of the Mortgagee shall be immediately due and payable.

9. No failure of the Mortgagee to exercise any option herein given to declare the maturity of the debt hereby secured shall be taken or construed as a waiver of its right to exercise such option or to declare such maturity by reason of any past or present delault on the part of the Mortgagor; and the procurement of insurance or the payment of taxes or other liens, debts, or charges by the Mortgagee shall not be taken or construed as a waiver of its right to declare the maturity of the indebtedness hereby secured by reason of the factors of the Mortga-

gor to procure such insurance or to pay such taxes, debts, liens, or charges.

10. As long as any of the indebtedness hereby secured shall remain unpaid the Mortgagor will neither commit nor permit waste on the premises hereby conveyed; and upon the commission of any waste thereon the Mortgagee may, at its option, declare the emaine indebtedness hereby secured to be at once due and payable. Nor will the Mortgagor remove any of the fixtures on the premises hereby comveyed so long as any of the indebtedness hereby secured shall remain unpaid.

11. If the Mos hall make default in the payment of any c jebtedness hereby secured, or in the perfect of any of the ms or conditions hereby, all the rents, income, and profits from the premises are hereby transferred, assigned, set over, and conveyed to Mortgagee, and the Mortgagee may proceed to collect the rent, income, and profits from the premises upon such default, either with or hout the appointment of a receiver; but the Mortgagee shall not hereby become bound by the terms of any lease then existing on the mises by electing to collect the rents thereunder, but may at any time terminate the same. Any rents, income, and profits collected by the rtgaged prior to foreclosure of this indebtedness, less the cost of collecting the same, including any real estate commission or attorney's incurred, shall be credited first, on the advances with interest thereon, then upon the interest, and the remainder, if any, upon the princidebt how by secured. 12. In consideration of the making of the loan secured by this mortgage, the Mortgagor, being all of the undersigned, covenant and ee that, in respect of the indebtedness secured hereby, they will forever waive, and they do hereby waive and give up all benefits, privies, options, and rights of every kind and nature given to or which inure to the benefit or advantage of the undersigned, or either of the lersigned if more than one, under and by virtue of House Bill No. 422 of the Legislature of Alabama of 1935, enacted into law and apved on June 24, 1935, commonly referred to as the Deficiency Judgment Act; and further agree to waive and forego any like or similar its, benefits, and options hereafter conferred upon mortgage debtors by law hereafter enacted; and further covenant and agree that the ebtedness hereby secured, and all extensions and renewals thereof, and this mortgage shall each be enforceable in accordance with their pective terms and conditions, without reference to and in spite of any provisions to the contrary in said Act of the Legislature of Alabamind any and all other laws of like or similar purport which may hereafter be enacted. 15.
