GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

TO

JACK R. THOMPSON, JR.

(4) Sign, seal, execute, acknowledge and deliver such deeds, leases and assignment of leases, agreements, mortgages, releases and satisfaction of mortgages and such other instruments in writing of whatever kind and nature as may be necessary or proper in the premises.

(5) I specially give to JACK R. THOMPSON, JR. the power to execute any and all documents, relative to closing of my home located at 1924 Indian Lake Drive, Birmingham, Alabama.
