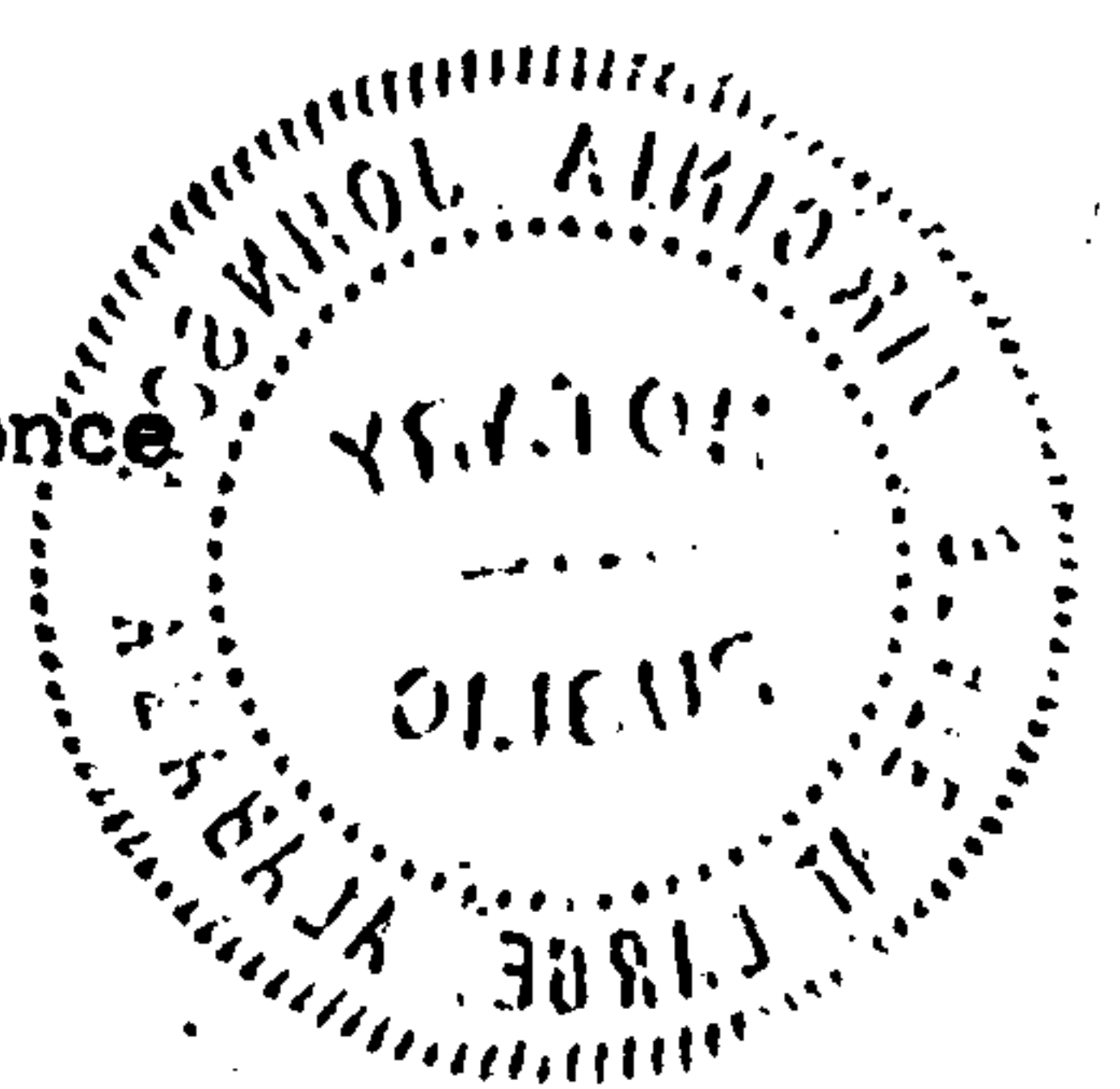
do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Clarence Yessick and wife, Essie Yessick, Doyle Yessick and Barbara Brantley
