This lease also covers and includes, in addition to that above described, all land, if any, contiguous or adjacent to or adjoining the land above described and (a) owned or claimed by lessor by limitation, prescription, possession, reversion or unrecorded instrument or (b) as to which lessor has a preference right of acquisition. Lessor agrees to execute any supplemental instrument requested by lesser for a more complete or accurate description of said land. For the purpose of determining the amount of any bonus or other payment hereunder, said land shall be deemed to contain

acres, whether actually containing more or less, and the above recital of acreage in any tract shall be deemed to be the true acreage thereof. Lessor accepts the booms as lump sum consideration for this lease and all rights, and options becomed.

2. If at any time that lessee pays or tenders shut-in royalty, two or more parties are, or claim to be, entitled to receive same, lessee may, in lieu of any other method of payment berein provided, pay or tender such shut-in royalty, in the manner above specified, either jointly to such parties or separately to each in accordance with their respective ownerships thereof, as lessee may close. Any payment hereunder may be made by chick or draft of lesser deposited in the mail or delivered to the party entitled to receive payment or to a depository bank provided for above on or before the last slate for payment. Nothing herein shall impair lessee's right to release as provided in paragraph 5 hereof. In the event of assignment of this lease in whole or in part, liability for payment hereunder shall rest exclusively on the then owner or owners of this lease, severally as to acroage owned by each.

4. Lessee is hereby granted the right, at its option, to peal or unjitize all or any part of said land and of this lease as to any or all minerals or horizons thereunder, with other lands, lease or leases, or portion or portions thereof, or mineral or horizon thereunder, so as to establish units containing not more than 80 surface acres plus 10% acreage tolerance; provided, however, a unit may be established or an existing unit may be enlarged to contain not more than 640 acres plus 10% acresge tolerance, if unitized only as to gas and liquid by drocarbons (condensate) which are not a liquid in the subsurface reservoir. If larger units are required, under any governmental rule or order, for the drilling or operation of a well-at a regular location, or for obtaining maximum allowable, from any well to be drilled, drilling, or already drilled, any such unit may be established or enlarged, to conform to the size required by such governmental order or rule. Lessee shall exercise said option us to each desired unit by executing an instrument identifying such unit and filing it for record in the public office in which this lease is recorded. Each of said options may be exercised by lessee from time to time, and whether before or after production has been established either on said land or on the portion of said land included in the unit or on other land unitized therewith and any such unit may include any well to be drilled, being drilled or already completed. A unit established hereunder shall be valid and effective for all purposes of this lease even though there may be land or mineral, royalty or leasehold interests in land within the unit which are not profed or unitized. Any operations conducted on any port of such unitized land dult be considered, for all purposes, except the payment of royalty, operations conducted under this lease. There shall be allocated to the land covered by this lease included in any such unit that proportion of the total production of unitized minerals from wells in the unit, after deducting any used to lease or unit operations, which the number of surface acres in the land covered by this lease included in the unit bears to the total number of surface acres in the unit. The production so allocated shall be considered for all purposes, including the payment or delivery of royalty: overriding royalty, and any other payments out of production, to the entire production of unitized minerals from the portion of said land covered hereby and included in such unit in the same manner as though produced from said land under the terms of this lease. The owner of the revisionary estate of any term royalty or mineral estate agrees that the accural of royalties pursuant to the paragraph or of shut-in royalties from a well on the unit shall citisfy any limitation of term requiring production of oil or gas. The formation of such unit shall not have the effect of changing the ownership of any shut-in production royalty which may become payable under this lease. Neither shall it impair the right of lease to release from this lease all or any portion of said land, except that lease may not so release as to lands within a unit while there are operations thereon for unitized uninerals unless all probed leases are released as to lands within the unit. Lessee may dissolve any unit established begennder by filling for record in the public office where this lease is recorded a declaration to that effect. If at that time no operations are being conducted thereon for unitized minerals. Subject to the provisions of this paragraph 4, a unit once established becomine shall remain in force so long as any lease subject thereto shall remain in force. A unit may be so established, modified or dissolved during the life of this lease

5. Lessee may at any time and from time to time execute and deliver to lessor or file for record a release or release of this lesse as to any part or all of said land or of any mineral or horizon theremoter, and thereby released of all obligations as to the released acreage or interest

6. This is a PAID-UP LEASE. In consideration of the down cash payment. Lessor agrees that Lessee shall not be obligated except as otherwise provided herein, to commence or continue any operations during the primary term. Whenever used to this losse the word "operations" shall mean operations for and any of the following drilling, testing, completing, recompleting, deepening, plugging back or reporting of a well in search for or in an endeavor to obtain production of oil, gas, sulphur or other minerals, escavating a mine, production of oil, gas, sulphur or other minerals, whether or not in paying quantities.

7. Leave shall have the use, free from royalty, of water, other than from lessor's water wells, and of oil and gas produced from said land in all operations bereinder. Lessee shall have the right at any time to remove all machinery grid fixtures placed on said land, including the right to draw and remove casing. 9. In the excit lesser considers that lesser has not complied with all its obligations bereinder, both express and implied, lesser shall notify lesser in writing, setting out specifically in what respects lesser has breached this contract. Lessee shall then have sixty (60) days after receipt of said notice within which to meet or communice to meet all or any part of the breaches alleged by lessor. The service of said notice nor the doing of any action by lessor on said lease for any cause, and no such action shall be brought until the lapse of sixty (60) days after service of such notice on lessee. Neither the service of said notice nor the doing of any acts by lesser aimed to meet all or any of the alleged breaches shall be deemed an admission or presumption that lessee has failed to perform all its obligations bereinder. Should it be assented in any notice given to the lessee under the provisions of this paragraph that lessee has failed to comply with any implied obligation or covenant berief, this lease shall not be subject to causedlation for any such came except after final judicial ascertainment that such failure exists and lessee has then been afforded a reasonable time to prevent cancellation by complying with and discharging its obligations as to which lessee has been judicially determined to be in default. If this lesse is cancelled for any cause, it shall nevertheless remain in force and effect as to (1) sufficient acreage around each well as to which there are operations to constitute a drilling or maximum allowable mut maker applicable governments regulations, (but in no event less than forty acres), such acreage to be designated by fessor as nearly as practicable in the form of a square confered at the well, or in such shall also have such easenests on said land as are recessary to operations to ensure a certain of the acreage so retained.

10 Lessor bends, warrants and agrees to defend title to said land against the claims of all persons whomsoever. If this lease owers a less interest in the oil, gas, sulphur, or other minerals in all or any part of said land then the rotire and undivided fee simple estate (whether lessor's interest is become querified or not), or no interest therein, then the royalties, and other moneys accruing from any part as to which this lease covers less than such full interest, shall be paid out of the royalty herein provided. This lease shall be binding upon each party who executes it without regard to whether it is executed by all those named berein as lessor.

11. If, while this lease is in force at, or after the expiration of the primary term hereof, it is not being continued in force by reason of the shut-in well provisions of paragraph 3 hereof, and leave is not conducting operations on said and by reason of (1) any law, order, rule or regulation (whether or not subsequently determined to be invalid) or (2) any other cause, whether similar or dissimilar, texcept financial) beyond the reasonable control of leaves, the primary term hereof shall be extended until the first anniversary date hereof occurring ninety (90) or more days following the removal of such delaying cause, and this leave may be extended thereafter by operations as if such delay had not occurred.

Lessee, for a period of lifteen days after receipt of the notice, shall have the prior and preferred right and option to purchase the lesse or part thereof or interest therein, covered by the offer at the price and according to the terms and conditions of this Section. Should Lessee elect to purchase the lesse pursuant to the terms hereof, it shall so notify Lessoe to writing by mad or electron prior to expiration of said 15-day period. Lessee shall promptly thereafter furnish to Lessor the new lesse for execution on behalf of Lesson's) along with Lessee's
