WARRANTY DEED, JOINT TENANTS WITH RIGHT OF SURVIVORSHIP

That in consideration of Seventeen Thousand and no/100 (\$17,000.00) DOLLARS
and assumption of the hereinafter described mortgage
to the undersigned grantor or grantors in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we,
John D. Apperson and wife, Helen A. Apperson

(herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto
Raymond J. Votava and wife, Rita A. Votava
(herein referred to as GRANTEES) as joint tenants with right of survivorship, the following described real estate situated in
Shelby County, Alabama to-wit:
