My name is John O. Leemon. My residence address is _____ . I have been familiar with the ownership, use and possession of the following described property, viz:

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for more than the past forty years. I have lived in the community of the above described property, having actually lived within a few miles of the property for many years.

I was well acquainted with William E. Allen during his lifetime and with his wife, Willie H. Allen during her lifetime. Mr. William E. Allen died approximately in the year 1978 and Mrs. Allen died about 1974 .

I know that Mr. and Mrs. Allen bought the above property from John W. Harmon in the 1940's, and recall that there was small log house on the property when they bought it, but Mr. and Mrs. Allen built a new house on the property and moved into the house and they continued to live there until each of their respective deaths, claiming the property as their homstead, cultivating portions thereof, planting a garden on the property from time to time.

I know of my own personal knowledge that said William E. Allen and wife, Willie H. Allen, and their daughter, Charlene Ross, subsequent to Mr. Allen's death, have been in the actual, exclusive, open, notorious, hostile, adverse and continuous possession of the above said property and I have never heard the title of the present owner or her predecessors in title questions in any way.
