Whitfield and Inez Whitfield, (hereafter called Grantee), all our right, title, interest and claim for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Beginning 70 yards South of the Northwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 10, Township 18, Range 1 East, running South 70 yards, thence East 140 yards, thence north 70 yards, thence west 140 yards, to the starting point, containing 2 acres, more or less.

This deed is given to correct a defect in title caused by an erroneous description contained in deed recorded in Deed Book 307, page 758, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said W.T. Whitfield and Inez Whitfield, for and during their joint lives, and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them.
