## FINAL ORDER

This case having come on for trial on the 7th day of May, 1984, and the Court having been informed of a settlement between the parties, Plaintiff and Defendants, Third Party Plaintiffs and Third Party Defendants, OO this order is entered pursuant to that agreement and is as follows:

An agreement was made between Robert L. Dawson, Jr. and wife Janice B. Dawson and James F. Cordes and wife Shirley V. Cordes in 1977. In that agreement, Mr. and Mrs. Crodes agreet to either pay Mr. and Mrs. Dawson the amount of \$850.00 per acre for 2.81 acres, or litigate title to that certain property which is the subject of this lawsuit. This action was brought in order to enforce that agreement. The Defendants, James F. Cordes and Shirley V. Cordes, filed a Third Party Action against Allied Products in order to quite title to that certian 2.81 acres, more or less.

The parties having agreed that the above referenced 2.81 acres should be titled to Robert Lee Dawson, Jr. and Janice B. Dawson, and that a northern boundary line for said property be established to generally coincide with a fence row which has existed for over 50 years, the parties have agreed that the correct legal description of the above referenced property is as shown on the survey of William J. Egan, Jr. of August 24, 1976, a copy of

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which is attached hereto as exhibit 'A', that description being as follows:

Begin at the Southeast (SE) corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE%) of the Northeast Quarter (NE%) of Section8, Township 24 North, Range 13 East, Shelby County, Alabama; and run West along the South line of said Quarter-Quarter line, a distance of 1415.21 feet, more or less, to the Southwest (SW) corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE%) of the Northeast Quarter (NE%) of Section8; thence turning an angle to the left of 100 deg. 40' 08", and running Northwesterly for a distance of 132.84 feet, more of less, to a point on an old fence line; thence turning an angle to the left of 75 deg. 47' 57", and running Southeasterly for a distance of 169.77 feet, more or less, to a second point on same old fence line; thence turning an angle to the left of 180 deg. 08' 36", and running Southeasterly a distance of 440.43 feet, more or less to a third point on same old fence line; thence turning an angle to the left of 179 deg. 58' 42", and running Southeasterly for a distance of 218.21 feet, more or less to a fourth point on same old fence line; thence turning an angle to the left of 179 deg. 28', and running Southeasterly a distance of 209.22 feet, more or less to a fifth point on same old fence line; thence turning an angle to the left of 181 deg. 10' 53" and running Southeasterly for a distance of 220.57 feet, more or less, to a sixth point on same old fence line; thence turning an angle to the left of 173 deg. 56' 58" and running Southeasterly a distance of 186.00 feet, more or less, to a seventh point on same old fence line, and also on the East Quarter-Quarter line of the Northeast Quarter (NE%) of the Northeast Quarter (NE%) of Section 8, thence turning an angle to the left of 98 deg. 50' 17" and running South along said Quarter-Quarter line for a distance of 27.57 feet, to the point of beginning.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that title to the above referenced property be vested in Robert Lee Dawson, Jr. and Janice B. Dawson. Costs of this action shall be taxed as paid.
