

DECLARATION OF RESULT OF SPECIAL THREE MILL DISTRICT
SCHOOL TAX ELECTION IN SCHOOL TAX DISTRICT NO. 2 IN
SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA

In accordance with the Resolution and Order of the Shelby County Commission of Shelby County, Alabama, made on the 26th day of September, 1984, a special election was held on the 6th day of November, 1984, in School Tax District No. 2 in Shelby County to determine whether or not an additional special district school tax of thirty cents (30¢) on each one hundred dollars (\$100) worth of taxable property in School Tax District No. 2 in said County, as assessed for County taxation, pursuant to the provisions of Amendment No. 382 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, shall be levied and collected annually for a period of nineteen years beginning with the levy for the tax year ending September 30, 1985 (the tax for which year will be due and payable October 1, 1985), and ending with the levy for the tax year ending September 30, 2003 (the tax for which year will be due and payable October 1, 2003), for public school purposes in School Tax District No. 2 in said County; said levy and collection to be in addition to any and all district school taxes presently levied and collected in said School Tax District No. 2 in said County pursuant to the provisions of Amendment No. 3 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901.

The Commission has found and determined that due notice of said election was given as required by law and by the Resolution and Order of the Commission, that said election was duly and legally held within School Tax District No. 2 in said County on the 6th day of November, 1984, that returns of said election have been made as provided by law, and that the results of said election are as follows:

9,589 FOR PROPOSED TAXATION

8,188 AGAINST PROPOSED TAXATION

The Commission has ordered, adjudged and decreed that a majority of the qualified electors of School Tax District No. 2 voting at said special election voted in favor of the levy and collection of said tax, that said tax shall be so levied and collected for public school purposes, and that the appropriate County officials are directed to assess and collect said tax for such period and for such purpose.
