My name is VIVIAN H. DENTY. I am 61 years of age and have been familiar with the following described property all of my life:

The above described property was owned by my grandfather L. L. Harris, and my father, Reece H. Harris inherited said property at my grandfather's death. My mother, Odessa W. Harris, married my father approximately 50 years ago and came to live on a portion of said property at that time. There was a big, old house on the property at that time and they lived in this house until it burned approximately 36 years ago. After that house burned, the house that is presently located on said property was built. During the years that my mother and father lived on said property, they raised a garden and kept the grass cut and generally kept the place up and did the usual things that are generally done by property owners. They also kept cattle on said property and used some of it as pastureland.

My father passed away 28 years ago and my mother died on August 23, 1984. Myself, Clara H. Whitney, Hope Hallowell and Jacqueline Hutto are the sole surviving heirs at law and next of kin of the said Reece H. Harris and Odessa W. Harris. I have one sister, Mary Alma Horton, who is deceased and she had no children.

Reese H. Harris, Jr. was adopted by my father and mother in about the year of 1950. Said Reese H. Harris, Jr. is unmarried at this time.
