If enactment or expiration of applicable laws has the effect of rendering any provision of this Mortgage or of the Credit Agreement unenforceable according to its terms, Mortgages, at its option, may require the immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Mortgage and may invoke any remedies parmitted hereunder.
