ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Alabama Business Corporation Act hereby adopts the following articles if incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE

NAME

The name of the corporation is Woodland Services Company, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO

DURATION

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE

PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to provide reforestation services, timber management, and to engage in any lawful business or activities related to the stated purpose and to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Alabama Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE FOUR

REGISTERED OFFICE

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 108 Sunnywood Circle, Columbiana, Alabama 35051.

ARTICLE FIVE

CAPITAL STOCK

The total number of shares that the corporation has authority to issue is 1000 shares, all of which shall be common shares with a par value of \$1.00 per share. There shall be no more than thirty-five shareholders. Stock shall be issued and transferable only to natural persons who are not nonresident aliens.

ARTICLE SIX

DIRECTORS

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors shall be the same number as the number of persons listed in this Article Seven.
