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5. So long as any of the indehtedness secured hereby shall remain unpaid, in whole or in part, the Mortgagor agrees to keep said prem-

ises and the improvements thereon in good condition, and to pay all assessments that may be levied or accrue upon said property, and all other charges that may become liens upon said premises, and not to permit any lien, which might take precedence over the lien of this mort-

gage, to accrue and remain on said premises, or any part thereof, or on the improvements thereon.

6. The Mortgagor agrees to pay all taxes and assessments that may be assessed upon said property and all taxes except income taxes that may be assessed upon the Mortgagee's interest thereon or upon this mortgage or the moneys secured hereby, any law to the contrary notwithstanding. Upon any violation of this undertaking, or the passage of any law imposing upon the Mortgagee the payment of any part of the taxes aforesaid, or upon the rendition by any court of last resort of a decision that the undertaking to pay the taxes as aforesaid is legalby inoperative, then, in any such event, the debt hereby secured shall at the Mortgagee's option, become immediately due and payable. without deduction, any law heretofore or hereafter enacted to the contrary notwithstanding.

7. That he will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property, insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and other hazards, casualties and contingencies in such amounts and for such periods as may be required by the Mortgagee and will pay promptly, when due, any premiums on such insurance provision for payment of which has not been made hereinbefore. In event of foreclosure of this mortgage or other transfer of title to the mortgaged property in extinguishment of the indebtedness secured hereby, all right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser or grantee.

In consideration of the making of the loan secured by this mortgage, the Mortgagor, being all of the undersigned, covenant and agree that, in respect of the indebtedness secured hereby, they will forever waive, and they do hereby waive and give up all benefits, privileges, options, and rights of every kind and nature given to or which inure to the benefit or advantage of the undersigned, or either of the undersigned if more than one, under and by virtue of House Bill No. 422 of the Legislature of Alabama of 1935, enacted into law and approved on June 24, 1935, commonly referred to as the Deficiency Judgment Act; and further agree to waive and forego any like or similar rights, benefits, and options hereafter conferred upon mortgage debtors by law hereafter enacted; and further covenant and agree that the indebtedness hereby secured, and all extensions and renewals thereof, and this mortgage shall each be enforceable in accordance with their respective terms and conditions, without reference to and in spite of any provisions to the contrary in said Act of the Legislature of Alabama, and any and all other laws of like or similar purport which may hereafter be enacted. 15.
