Article One

Name

The name of the corporation is Alabama B.M.X.
Association.

Article Two

Duration

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual
and its corporate existence will commence on the filing of
these articles of incorporation with the Judge of Probate.

Article Three

Purposes

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is
organized are:

1. Primarily for the expansion and promotion of the
sport of bicycle motocross for nonprofit, athletic and civic
purposes, including the organization and conduct of
competitive events in the sport of bicycle motocross.

2. Generally to have and exercise all rights and
powers conferred on nonprofit corporations under the laws of
Alabama or which may hereafter be conferred, including the

power to contract, rent, buy, or sell personal or real property; provided, however, that this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purpose of this corporation.

3. Notwithstanding any of the above statements of purposes and powers, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purpose of this corporation, and nothing contained in the foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed to authorize this corporation to carry on any activity for the profit of its members, or to distribute any gains, profits, or dividends to its members.

Article Four

Classes of Members

The membership of the corporation shall be divided into two classes, designated as follows: (1) Voting members (2) Non-voting members. The qualifications and rights of the members of each class shall be specified in the Constitution and the By-Laws of the corporation.

Article Five

Conduct of Corporation Affairs

The business and affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the Governing Board of Directors. The rights and duties of said Directors, their manner of election or

nomination and their terms of office shall be specified by the Constitution and By-Laws of the corporation.

Article Six

Registered Office and Agent

The initial registered office of the corporation shall be located at 22 Inverness Center Parkway, Suite 610, Birmingham, Alabama 35242. The initial registered agent of the corporation at that address shall be Mark D. McKnight.

Article Seven

Initial Board of Directors



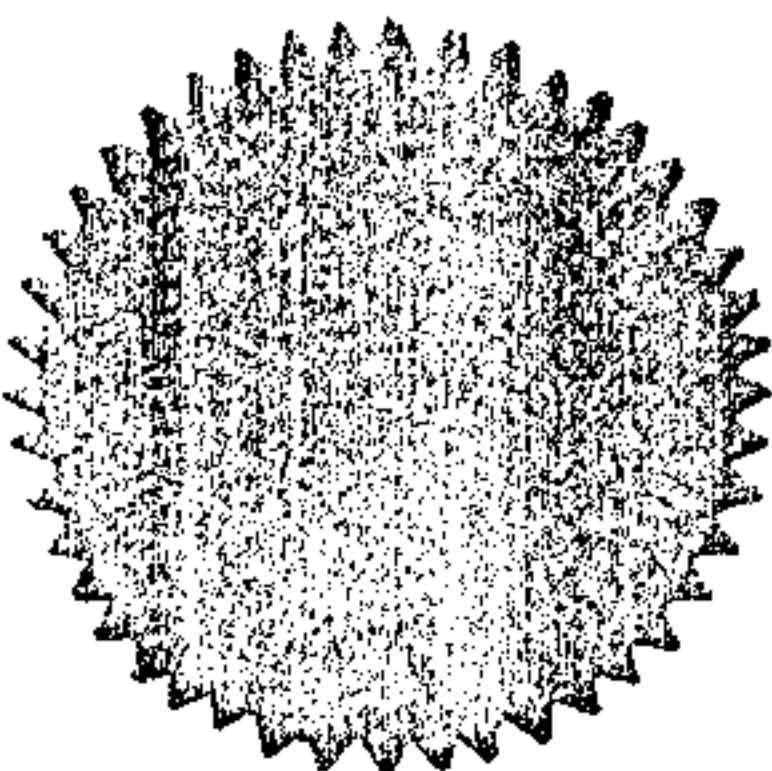
