and we hereby waive our right to claim personal property exempt under the laws of Alabama.

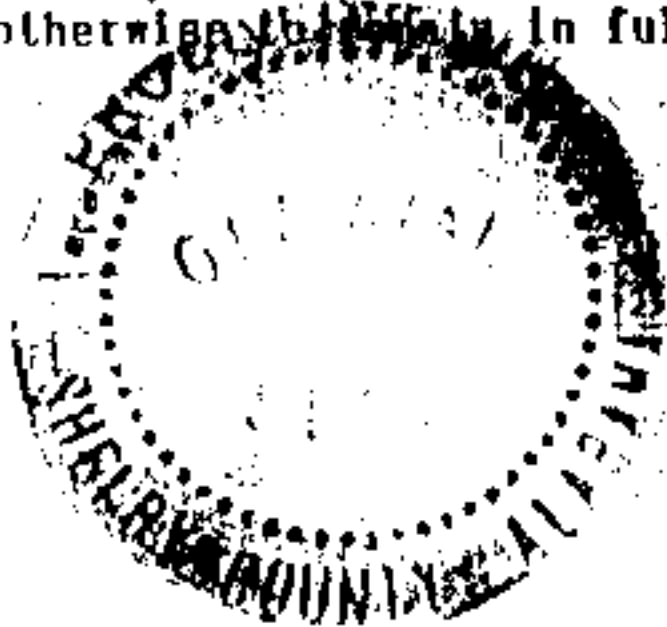
