and more less or divided as hereinafter
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-

acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said James M. Dyer
the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appur-
tenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said James M. Dyer
and his heirs and assigns forever.
