ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
The Pesek Corporation

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Alabama Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is
The Pesek Corporation

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

(a) Sales, Service, Manufacturing, Programming and support of Computers, Communications Equipment, Software and Related Products.

(b) To engage in the business of organization and promoting corporation, exporting, importing, buying, selling, or otherwise trading in or dealing in the manufacturing of products for a profit and to do and perform all acts as are reasonably necessary for the purpose of buying, selling, and manufacturing of products including the right to hypothecate or mortgage any of the same owned by the corporation.

(c) To borrow money for any purpose of the corporation and from time to time, without limit as to amount, to draw, to make, to execute and issue promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange, warrant, bonds, debentures and other negotiable instruments and evidence of indebtedness, and to secure the prompt payment thereof and of the interest thereon by mortgage on pledge, conveyance of assignment in trust of, the whole or any part of the assets of the corporation, real or personal.

(d) To discount any promissory note, draft, bill of exchange, warrant, bond and other negotiable or any other evidence of indebtedness, with or without recourse as may be determined by the Board of Directors.

(e) To lend any capital funds or monies of the corporation as it may from time to time lawfully acquire upon such security, personal or real property mixed, as may be agreed upon between the corporation and the borrower.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 100 shares, having a par value of \$1.00 per share.

FIFTH: Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are governed by a set of By-laws which are to be determined by the Board of Directors.


