ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ALABAMA CLASSIC HOMES, INC.

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation pursuant to the laws of the State of Alabama and acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under the Code of Alabama, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

I

The name of the corporation shall be Alabama Classic Homes, Inc.

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 2805 Montgomery Highway, Pelham, Alabama 35124, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Liz Bishop.

III

The nature of the business and the object and the purposes for which this corporation is formed are and include, as fully and to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, subject only to such limitations and restrictions as are placed on corporations under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Alabama, the following:

(a) To engage in the general speculative home building business, including the erection of homes, flats, and apartments; to operate a contracting business; to purchase, own, hold and sell real property, improved and unimproved, or any interest therein or easement thereon; to purchase lands and subdivide the same into subdivisions or lots; to loan money upon real property and to accept secured and unsecured notes as collateral for same; to execute notes, deeds of trust, mortgages, and chattel mortgages; to enter into leases as landlord or tenants; to perform or do any act customarily performed or done by a contractor and building, speculative builder, subdivider, or real property developer; to invest in and hold for investment any real property, shares of

stock, bonds, government, private, or corporate; and to exchange and enter into agreements of exchange of one parcel of real property.

- (b) To purchase, sell, rent as lessor or lessee, repair, and deal generally in new and used prefabricated living quarters of every kind and variety including, but not limited to, campers, house trailers and portable tents; and to purchase, sell, rent as lessor, and deal generally in and with furnishings, accessories, and parts for such products.
- (c) To take, own, hold, deal in, mortgage or otherwise give lien against and to lease, sell, buy, exchange, transfer and, in any manner, dispose of or deal with real property of every class or description, and any and all interest therein, both within and without the State of Alabama, wherever situated.
- (d) To manufacture, purchase or otherwise acquire, in any lawful manner, and hold, own, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise to give liens against and to lease, sell, assign, exchange, transfer, or, in any manner, dispose of, to deal and trade in and with, and to invest in goods, wares, merchandise and property of any and every class and description, both within and without the State of Alabama, and in any part of the world.
- without any limitation as to amount, to borrow and raise monies, to draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, execute, pledge, issue, sell or otherwise dispose of promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange, warrants, bonds and other instruments, whether transferable, and other evidence of indebtedness, whether secured by mortgage or otherwise, either alone or jointly with any other person or corporation; to confer upon the holders of any of its obligations such rights, powers, and pledges as from time to time might be deemed advisable by the Board of Directors, except as may be specifically prohibited by law; to lend money with or without collateral or other security.
 - (f) To enter into, make and perform contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality or body politic.
 - (g) To purchase, insofar as the same may be done without impairing capital of the corporation, except as otherwise permitted by law, and to hold, pledge, and reissue shares of its own capital stock, as determined by the Board of Directors.

- (h) To do any and all of the things herein set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do and in any part of the world as principals, agents, contractors, trustees or otherwise, and either alone or in the company of others.
- In general, to carry on any other business in connection therewith and to do all things not forbidden by the laws of the State of Alabama and with all the powers conferred upon corporations by the laws of the State of Alabama. It is the intention that each of the objects, purposes and powers specified in each of the paragraphs of this third article of these Articles of Incorporation shall, except where otherwise specified, be nowise limited or restricted articles, but that the objects, purposes and powers specified in this article and in each of the articles and paragraphs of these Articles of Incorporation shall be regarded as independent objects, purposes, and powers and the enumeration of specific objects, purposes and powers shall not be construed to restrict, in any manner, the general powers and terms of this corporation nor shall the expression of any one thing be deemed to exclude another, although it be of like nature.
- (j) To transact any and all lawful business for which it is entitled by Alabama Code Title 10, Section 2A-20, 1975, as amended.
- (k) To do any and all things normal or necessary in the conducting of the business of the above, whether wholesale or retail, in a commercial operation.

The corporation shall have the authority to issue one hundred (100) shares of common stock at Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per share par value.
