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## DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

Make, seal and deliver, bargain, contract, agree for, buy, sell, mortgage, hypothecate and in any and every way and manner deal in and with goods and personal property and any other property, fixtures or otherwise, in possession or in action.

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Bargain, contract, agree for, purchase, receive and take lands, and real property, tenements, hereditaments and accept the seizen and possession of all lands and deeds, lease, bargain, sell (release and satisfy mortgages), release and make satisfactions of other liens, judgment or other encumbrances, convey, mortgage and hypothecate real property, tenements, hereditaments, upon such terms and conditions, and under such covenants as he shall deem advisable.

Sign, seal, execute, acknowledge and deliver such deeds, leases, assignment of leases, agreements, mortgages, and such other instruments and documents in writing of whatever kind and nature as may be necessary or proper in the premises.

I hereby give and grant unto my attorney-in-fact full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite, necessary and/or advisable to be done in and about the premises (including but not limited to the specific powers granted herein), as fully and to all intent and purposes as I might or could do if personally present or able.

Further, I do nominate by this Durable Power of Attorney CYNTHIA BURCH BELYEU to be my guardian in the event of my disability, incompetency or incapacity. In the event court proceedings become necessary to appoint a guardian, it is my wish

and desire that the within named persons be appointed by the court.

I hereby ratify and confirm all that my attorney-in-fact, as my true and lawful attorney, shall do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.
