Together with all the rights, privileges, tenements, appurtenences and todures appertaining to the Real Estate, all pl which shall be deemed Real Estate and conveyed by this mortgage To have and to hold the Real Estate unto the Mortgages, its successors and assigns forever. The Mortgagors covenant with the Mortgages that the Mortgagors are lawfully sexed n fee simple of the Real Estate and have a good right to sell and convey the Real Estate as aforesaid, that the Real Estate is free of all encumbrances, unless otherwise set forth harein. and that the Mortgagors will warrant and forever defend the title to the Real Estate unto the Mortgages, against the claims of all persons.

This mortgage is junior and subordinate to the mortgage or mortgages (hereinater called individually a "Senior Mortgage" and jointly the "Senior Mortgages"), if any, described hereinabove I is specifically agreed that it default should be made in the payment of principal, interest or any other sums payable under the terms and provisions of any Senior Mongage, the Mongages shall have the right (but not the obligation), without notice to anyone, to make good such default by paying whatever amounts may be due under the terms of any Senior Mortgage to as to put the same in good standing, and any and all payments so made, together with interest thereon, shall be added to the Obligations secured by this mortgage, and the same. with interest thereon at the rate of interest (the "Added Debt Interest Rate") equal to the rate of interest charged by the Mortgages on the portion of the Obligations bearing the highest nterest rate (or such teaser rate of interest as shall be the maximum rate of interest permitted by applicable law), shall be immediately due and payable; and, in the event such amounts are not paid in full when due, at the option of the Mortgagee, this mortgage shall be subject to immediate foreclosure in all respects as provided by law and by the provisions hareof The Mortgagors hereby authorize the holder of any Senior Mortgage encumbering the Real Estate to disclose to the Mortgages the following information: (1) the amount of indebtedness secured by such Senior Mortgage; (2) the amount of such indebtedness that is unpaid; (3) whether any amount owed on such Indebtedness is or has been in streams; (4) whether there

e or has been any default with respect to such Senior Mortgage or the Indebtedness secured thereby; and (5) any other information regarding such Senior Mortgage or the indebtedness recured thereby that the Mortgages may request from time to time.

For the purpose of further securing the Obligations, the Mortgagors agree to: (1) pay all taxes, assessments, and other non-consensual tiens taking priority over this mortgage (here-natter ointly called "Liene"), and Il delauit is made in the payment of the Liens, or any part thereol, the Mongages, at its option, may pay the same; (2) keep the Real Estate continuously nsured. In such manner and with such companies as may be satisfactory to the Mortgages, against loss by fire, vandatism, maticious mischief and other parks usually covered by a ire insurance policy with standard extended coverage endorsement, with loss, if any, payable to the Mortgages, as its Interest may appear; subject, however, to the rights and interests of the holder or holders of any Senior Mongages, if any. Such insurance shell be in an amount at least equal to (a) the amount of the Obligations, plus the aggregate amount of indebtedness secured by any Benior Mongages covering the Real Estate or (b) the full insurable value of the improvements located on the Real Estate, whichever shall be less. The insurance solicy must provide that it may not be canceled without the insurer's giving at least ten days' prior written notice of such cancellation to the Mortgages. The Mortgagors hereby assign and pledge to the Mortgages, as further ascurity for the Obligations, each and every policy of hazard insurance now or hereafter in effect that insures said improvements, or any part hereof, together with all the right, title and interest of the Mortgagors in and to each and every such policy, including but not limited to, all of the Mortgagors' right, title and interest n and to any premiums peld on such hazard insurance, including all rights to returned premiums; subject, however, to the rights and interests of the holders of any Senior Mortgages I the Mortgagors fall to keep the Resi Estate insured as specified above, then, at the election of the Mortgages, this mortgage may be foreclosed as hersinalter provided, and, the viorigages may, but shall not be obligated to, insure the Real Estate for its full insurable value (or for such lesser amount as the Mortgages may wish) against such risks of loss, for is own benefit, the proceeds from such insurance fless the cost of collecting the same), it collected, to be credited against the Obligations secured by the lien of this mortgage, or, at he election of the Mortgagee, such proceeds may be used in repairing or reconstructing the Improvements located on the Real Estate. The Mortgages may apply all such sums so received, or any part thereof, after the payment of all the Mortgages's expenses, including court costs and attorneys' less, to the extent provided for herein, on the Obligations secured by the lien of this mortgage in such manner as the Mortgages elects, or, at the Mortgages's option, the entire amount or any part thereol so received may be released or may be used to rebuild, rapair or restors any or all of the improvements located

After default on the part of the Mortgagors, the Mortgagee, upon bill filed or other proper legal proceeding being commenced for the foreclosure of this mortgage, shall be entitled to the appointment by any competent court, without notice to any party, of a receiver for the rents, issues and profits of the Real Estate, with power to lease and control the Real Estate.
