- (b) to make contracts, guarantees, and indemnity agreements and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the corporation may determine, issue its notes, bonds, and other obligations, and secure any of its obligations by mortgage, pledge of, or creation of security interests in any of its obligations by

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its property or any interest therein.

- (c) To conduct its business, carry on its operations and have offices and exercise its powers within or without the State of Alabama.
- (d) To have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect its purposes.
- (e) To transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Alabama Business Corporation Act.

The foregoing clauses in this paragraph shall be construed as objects and purposes of the corporation in addition to any powers specifically conferred upon the corporation by law, and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing specific enumeration of powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of the corporation otherwise granted by law.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have the authority to issue is One Thousand (1,000) shares of common stock with a par value of one (\$1.00) dollar per share.

FIFTH: The corporation shall have the authority to apply to the Internal Revenue Service for treatment as a "Subchapter S" corporation.

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
