KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, ROBERT POW WALKER, a resident of Jefferson County, Alabama being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this instrument as and for my Last Will and Testament, hereby expressly revoking any and all wills, codicils or other testamentary dispositions heretofore made by me.

ITEM ONE:

I hereby direct that all of my just debts shall be paid by my personal representative as soon as practicable after my death.

I hereby give, devise ITEM TWO: and bequeath my entire estate of whatsoever kind and character and wherever situated or located, including real, personal and mixed property, seized and possessed by me or to which I may be entitled at the time of my death, unto my beloved wife, RUBYE B. WALKER, if living at the time of my death, to be held and owned by her absolutely and forever.

In the event my said ITEM THREE: wife, RUBYE, and I shall die in a common accident or disaster, or under any circumstances creating any doubt as to which of us survived the other, my said wife shall be presumed to have survived me for all purposes under this Will.

I hereby confer upon,

(a) To sell,

(b) To borrow any

sum of money and to secure the same by pledging, hypothecating, mortgaging all or any part of the assets at any time belonging to my estate.

(c) To execute and

(d) To retain the

securities originally belonging to my estate regardless of whether or not the same constitute legal investments under the laws of Alabama.

Executrix.
