## ORDER

Counsel. Counsel for the plaintiff, Brown Lumber & Building Supply, Inc., is F. Hilton-Green Tomlinson. Counsel for the defendants Truman Barefield, Randy Barefield and Wayne Barefield as partners d/b/a Barefield Construction Company, a partnership, is Ronald W. Waldrop. Counsel for the defendants, Stephen R. Truck and Sarah E. Truck is Douglas Corretti.

This case came on for hearing on the motion for partial summary judgment as amended filed by Brown Lumber & Building Supply, Inc. Brown Lumber & Building Supply makes claim against the individual partners, Truman Barefield, Randy Barefield and wayne Barefield and the partnership under which they were doing business, namely, Barefield Construction Company, for materials sold to Barefield Construction Company for which Brown Lumber & Building Supply has not been paid.

Having considered the evidence, this Court is of the opinion that the motion for partial summary judgment filed by Brown Lumber & Building Supply, Inc., against the Barefields is due to

be granted. The calculation of the amount due is as follows:

Interest calculated at 1½% per month or 18% per annum for a period of 1.104 years

\$16,884.54

Accordingly, judgment is hereby rendered in favor of Brown Lumber & Building Supply, Inc., and against Wayne Barefield, Randy Barefield and Truman Barefield, individually and as partners of Barefield Construction Company, a partnership, in the amount of \$16,884.54.

## FURTHER PROCEEDINGS

W. Ronald Waldrop as counsel for the Barefields and Barefield Construction Company has stated to the Court that the Barefields and Barefield Construction Company intend to file a crossclaim against Stephen R. Trucks and Sarah E. Trucks.

It is hereby ordered that the Barefields and Barefield Construction Company are allowed until Monday, November 2, 1992, within which time to file such crossclaim.
