

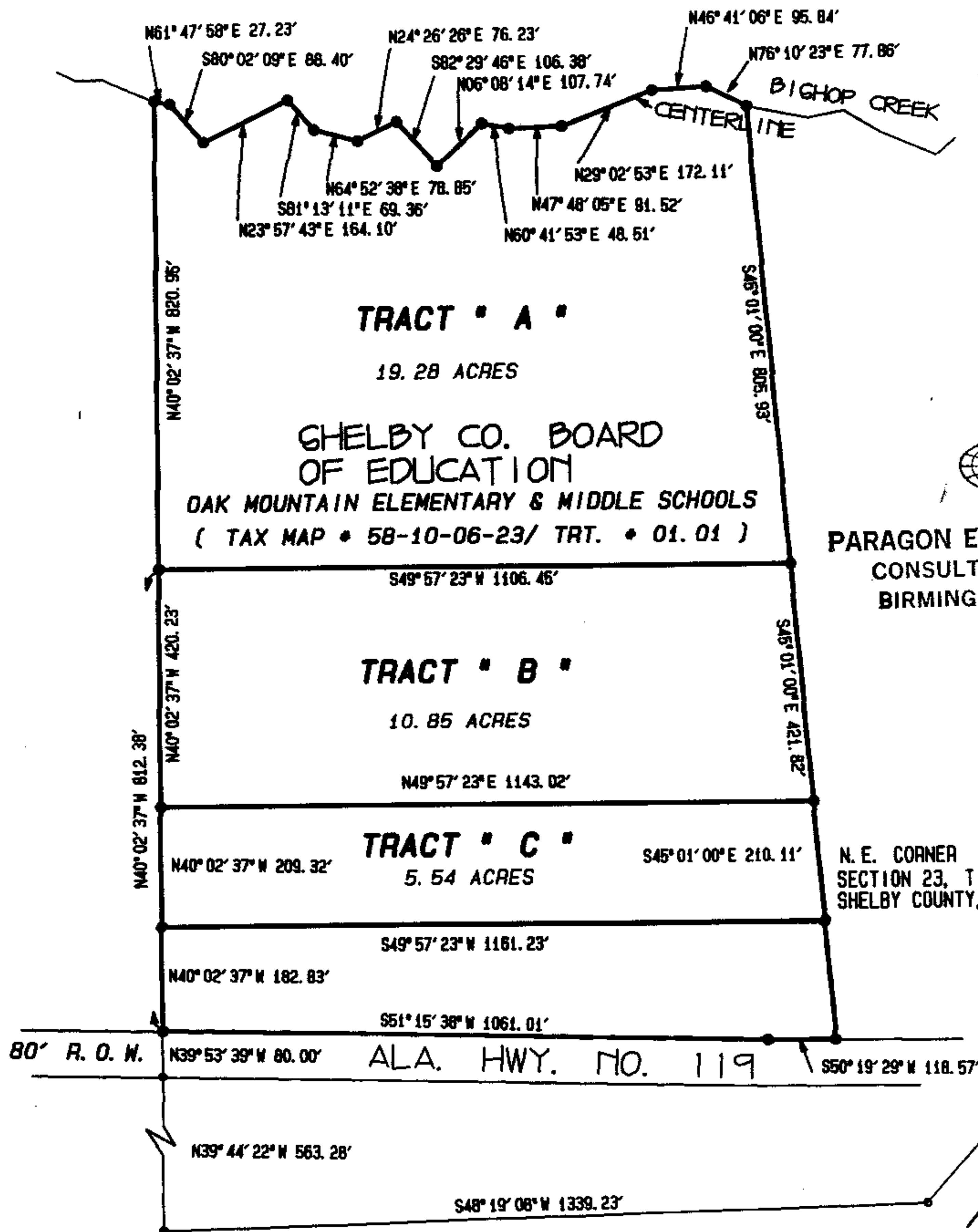

TRACT "B"

Part of the Northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama, being more particularly described as follows:

Commence at the Northeast corner of said Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama, and run South  $2^{\circ}06'38''$  West a distance of 1339.25 feet to a point; thence South  $48^{\circ}19'08''$  West a distance of 1339.23 feet to a point; thence North  $39^{\circ}44'22''$  West a distance of 563.28 feet to a point on the Southeasterly right-of-way of Alabama Highway #119; thence North  $39^{\circ}53'39''$  West a distance of 80.0 feet to a point on the Northwesternly right-of-way of said Alabama Highway #119; thence North  $40^{\circ}02'37''$  West a distance of 392.15 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING of the herein described tract; thence continue North  $40^{\circ}02'37''$  West a distance of 420.23 feet; thence North  $49^{\circ}57'23''$  East a distance of 1106.45 feet; thence South  $45^{\circ}01'00''$  East a distance of 421.82 feet; thence South  $49^{\circ}57'23''$  West a distance of 1143.02 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING. Contains 10.85 acres, more or less.



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
