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#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

#### WALKER ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICE COMPANY, INC.

#### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Alabama Business Corporation Act under the 1975 Code of Alabama, as last amended, adopt the following articles of incorporation for such corporation:

#### NAME OF CORPORATION

FIRST: The name of the corporation is WALKER ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICE COMPANY, INC.

#### DURATION OF CORPORATION

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

#### PURPOSE OR PURPOSES OF CORPORATION

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- (1) To provide environmental consulting service and to own and develop real estate and to do any and all other things related thereto.
- (2) To do such other things as are incidental, proper or necessary to the operation of the business, or to the carrying out of the objects, purposes, powers and privileges herein granted, as well as to exercise all those powers expressly conferred on business corporations and enumerated in

the Alabama Business Corporation Act, Acts of Alabama, 1980, 1975 Code of Alabama, as last amended, together with all other rights bestowed upon such corporation under the laws of the State of Alabama.

(3) To do any and all things herein set forth, and in addition, such other acts and things as are necessary to attainment of the purposes of this corporation, or any of them to the same extent as natural persons might or could do in any part of the world, insofar as such acts are permitted to be done by a corporation organized under the General Corporation Acts of the State of Alabama.

#### CAPITAL STOCK

FOURTH: (1) The total number of shares of stock which the corporation shall have the authority to issue shall be 100 shares of common stock of a par value of \$10.00 per share. The total of authorized capital stock is thus 100 shares and all of said stock shall be common, and none shall be preferred stock, or stock of a different class.

(2) The corporation will begin business with 100 shares of said common stock of the aggregate value of \$1,000.00 fully paid for as shown by the subscription list hereinafter set out.

FIFTH: The address of the initial registered agent office of the corporation is 2554 North Chandalar Lane, Pelham, Alabama 35124, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is David Earl Walker.

SIXTH: The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is two and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until their successors are elected and shall qualify are:

EIGHTH: All of the issued shares of stock authorized herein shall be subject to the restrictions on transfer provided in \$10-2A-41 of the 1975 Code of Alabama, as last amended. Further, for purposes of determining the number of holders of record of the stock of said corporation, stock which is held in joint or common tenancy or by the entireties, shall be treated as held by one shareholder.

#### SPECIAL PROVISIONS

NINTH: (1) The stockholders shall have authority to adopt such rules, by-laws, and regulations for the governing of the corporation as they deem necessary or expedient.

- (2) Holders of common stock shall be entitled to one vote for each and every share of stock standing in his, hers or its name at any and all meetings of the stockholders of the corporation, and said stock may be voted by the stockholders of record, either in person or by proxy.
- (3) Each stockholder shall have a pre-emptive right, as defined by the laws of the State of Alabama, to purchase or acquire additional or treasury shares of stock in the corporation.
- (4) The business and affairs of the corporation shall be under the management and control of a Board of Directors, said Board to consist of not

less than two nor more than seven persons. In the event of the death or resignation of a director, or the refusal of a person elected a director to accept his election as such, or to otherwise qualify as such the remaining directors shall elect his successor. All officers and directors shall hold office for a period of one year, or until their respective successors are duly elected and qualified.

- (5) The shares of capital stock in the corporation, when fully paid for in accordance with the subscription therefor, or sale thereof, as authorized or provided by law, shall be fully and non-assessable; and in no case shall any stockholder be individually liable otherwise than for the unpaid stock subscribed for by him.
- (6) The corporation shall have a lien on the shares of its stockholders for any debt or liability incurred to it by a stockholder before a notice of transfer or levy on each such shares, and shall have all the rights in respect thereto, and with respect to the enforcing of said lien as are now, or may be hereafter conferred by the laws of the State of Alabama.
- (7) The dates on which the stockholders' annual meeting shall be held, the number of directors and their terms of office, and the terms of office of the officers, and the powers and duties of the officers, shall be fixed by the by-laws of the corporation. Other officers than those named may be created by the by-laws and filled by the Board of Directors. The corporation shall have the power to make by-laws for the regulation and government of the corporation, its agents, servants and officers, and for all other purposes not inconsistent with the Constitution and the laws of the State of Alabama.
- (8) The corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, modify, change or repeal any provision contained in this certificate of incorporation

in the manner now or hereafter provided by law, and all rights conferred upon the officers, directors and stockholders herein are granted subject to this reservation.
