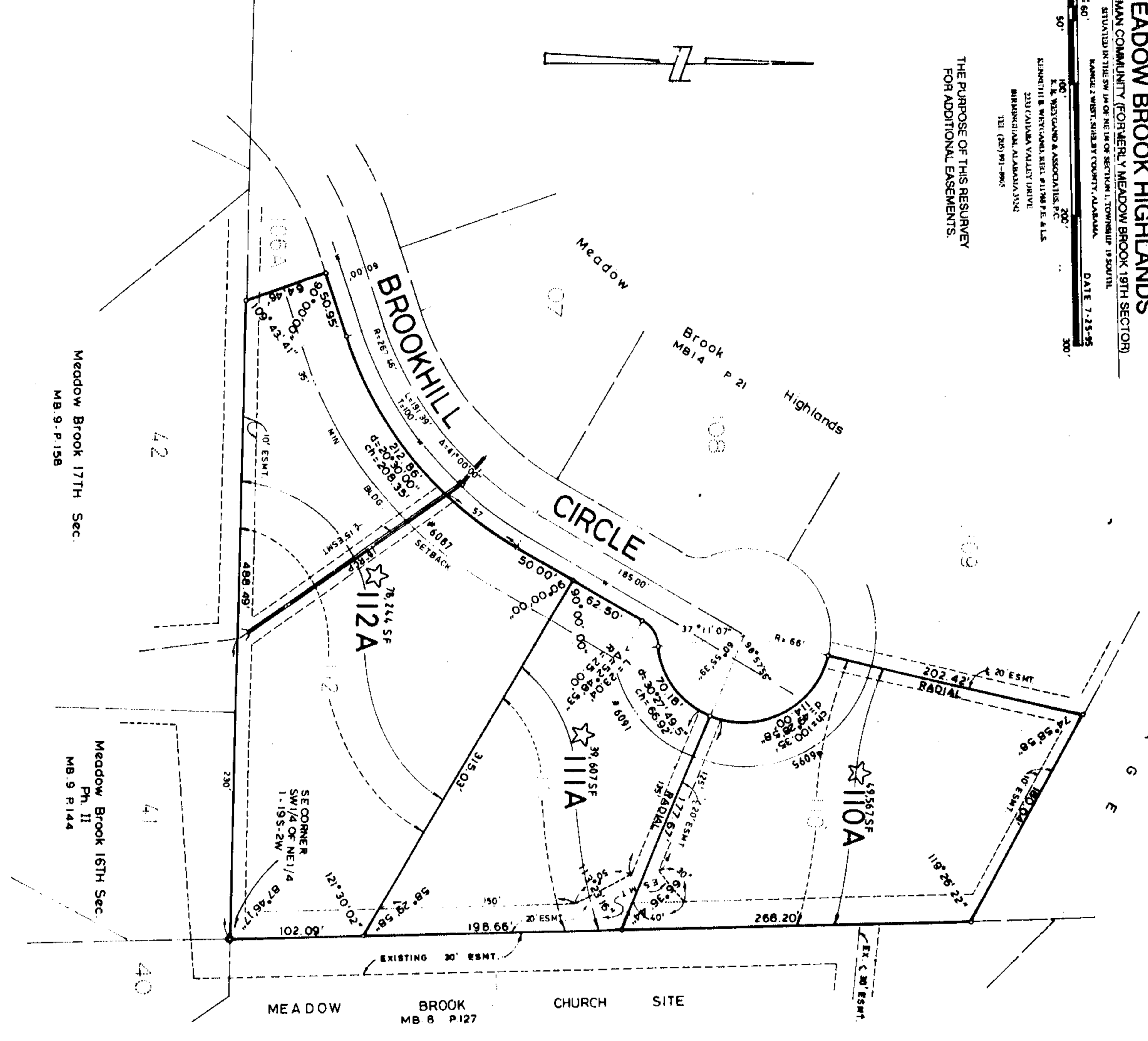

8. Lot 96 is not approved for a conventional disposal system due to groundwater conditions (only existing) at 37'. Lot may be submitted as an alternative system.
9. Pumping station to be required for the disposal fields adjacent to the street on lots 98, 99, 100, 101, 102, and 103.
10. Secondary disposal field on lot 108 located in an area of slopes 25% and cannot be approved as a conventional system. Lot may be submitted as an alternative system.
11. Lots 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99, 107 and 108 are not approved as conventional disposal systems. The depth was less than 22 inches. Lots may be submitted as alternative systems.
12. Lot 104 is with-hold pending location of soils tests on that lot.
13. Lot 104 is not approvable because of inadequate, unstable areas for disposal fields.
14. Lots 96, 98, 99, 100, 101, 102, and 103 are not approvable.
