

RESOLUTION NO. 1516-95

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Hoover has received a petition in multiple parts requesting the Council to take such action as may be necessary to cause the property described in the legal description included with the said petitions and as depicted on the map included therewith into the City of Hoover; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Hoover has reviewed the petitions and legal description and the map submitted to it and is of the opinion that it is proper to act in connection with the requests contained therein:

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Hoover in regular meeting duly assembled, a quorum being present, as follows:


1. The public health and public good of the City of Hoover and of the residents and owners of property located within the property described in that certain legal description attached hereto, requires that the said territory be brought within the limits of the City of Hoover.

2. The plat or map filed with the petitions attached hereto show accurately the territory proposed to be embraced within the corporate limits of the City of Hoover, including all subdivisions into lots, blocks, streets and alleys within such territory, and the said petitions have attached thereto and included therein an accurate description by metes and bounds of the boundary of such territory, which territory is contiguous to the boundary and will form a homogeneous part of the City of Hoover and does not extend to or around the boundary line of any other city or town and does not embrace any territory within the corporate limits of another municipality.

3. The Council further finds and determines that there are at least two qualified electors residing, according to government survey, on each quarter of each quarter section or part thereof of the above described territory and who have assented to such annexation in writing by signing the petitions together with the consent of the person, firms, or corporations owning at least 60 percent of the acreage of all platted or unplatted lands within the said territory who have also consented to such annexation by signing the said petition.

4. The Council of the City of Hoover does hereby request the Mayor of the City and the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, to take such action as may be necessary, under the provisions of Title 11-42-2, Code of Alabama, to cause the said territory to be annexed into the City of Hoover including the calling of an election as provided in the said statute.

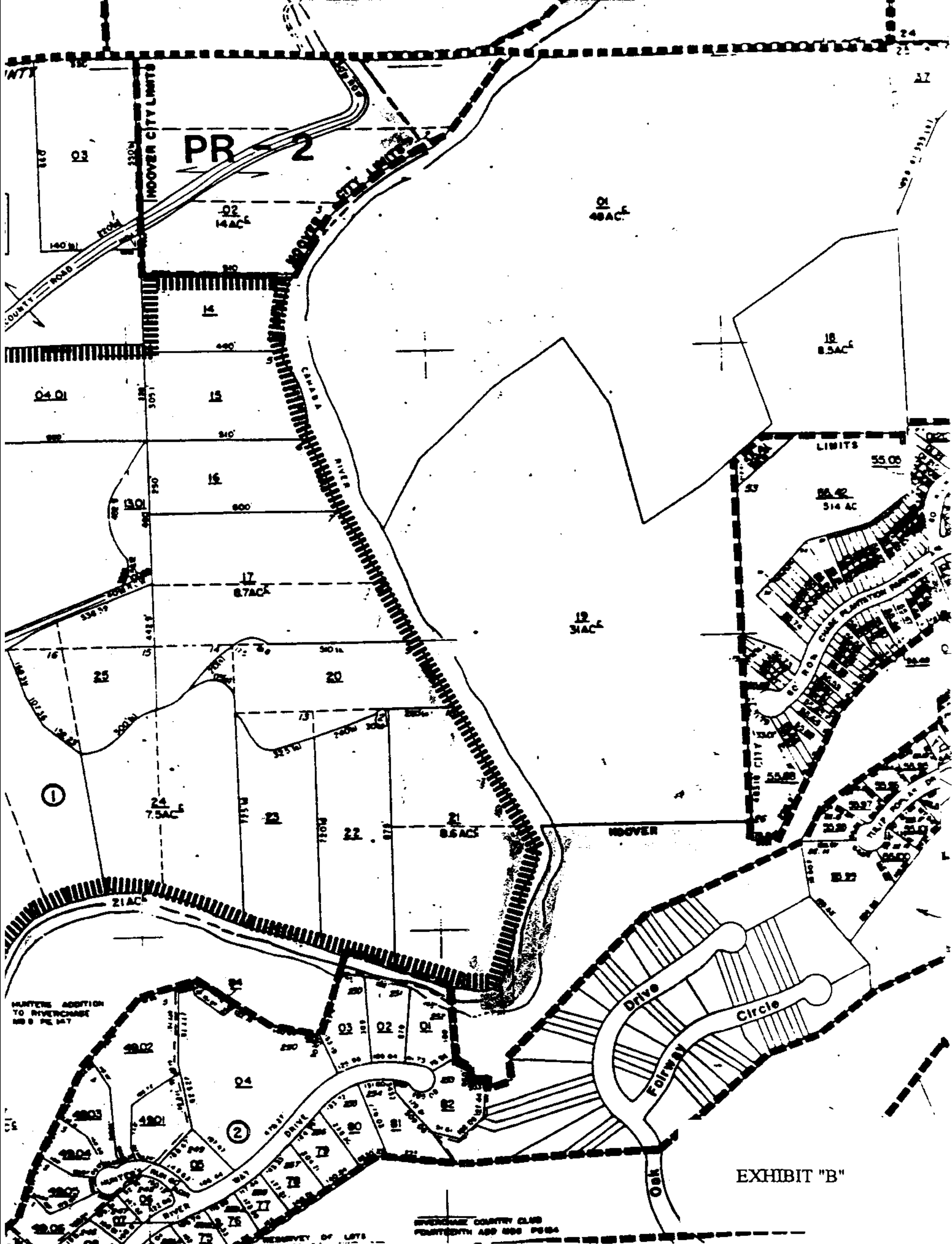

## EXHIBIT "A"

1. The south one-half of the northwest one-quarter of Section 26, Township 19 South, Range 3 West.
2. The north one-half of the southwest one-quarter of Section 26, Township 19 South, Range 3 West that lies north and northwest of the present City Limits of the City of Hoover.
3. The northwest one-quarter of the southeast one-quarter of Section 26, Township 19 South, Range 3 West that lies north and west of the present City Limits of the City of Hoover.
4. The southwest one-quarter of the northeast one-quarter of Section 26, Township 19 South, Range 3 West that lies southwesterly of the southwesterly bank of the Cahaba River.
5. The southwest one-quarter of the northeast one-quarter of the northwest one-quarter of Section 26, Township 19 South, Range 3 West.
6. All that property described and recorded in Real Book 261, Pages 430 and 431 in the office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama.
7. All that property described and recorded in Real Book 153, Page 707 in the office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama.
8. Lots 4 and 5 according to the Survey of Cahaba River Estates as recorded in Map Book 3, Page 11 in the office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama.
9.
