WHEREAS, it has been determined that slight modifications in the boundary lines existing between Commission District Five and Commission District Six as defined in the aforesaid Resolution 92-01-13-13 should be made in order to provide for the convenience of voters residing in such districts and,

WHEREAS, prior to the consideration of this resolution, the County Commission has caused to be advertised in a newspaper of general circulation in Shelby County for at least two consecutive weeks, a notice giving the time and place of this meeting at which this resolution is being considered and,

WHEREAS, said advertisement notified all concerned that a map indicating the proposed district boundaries and the changes herein contemplated was and is available for inspection at Shelby County Department of Planning and Development, 200 West College Street, Columbiana, Alabama, where said map was and has been displayed for at least two consecutive weeks preceding the meeting of the Shelby County Commission at which this resolution is being considered, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed that such modifications and changes as herein provided for are in the best interest of Shelby County and its citizens and will result in a more orderly and efficient election process:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SHELBY COUNTY COMMISSION AS FOLLOWS:

1. For the purposes of this resolution, and for future election of members to the County Commission, Shelby County is hereby divided into nine subdivisions, to be known as districts, and to be numbered One through Nine, inclusive. Each said district shall embrace and be composed of that portion of Shelby County contained within the designated boundaries of such districts as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made part and parcel hereof as fully as if set out herein.

- 2. Beginning in 1996, and each four years thereafter, each member of the County Commission shall be nominated and elected by the voters of Shelby County residing in the district in which such member resides. The voters allowed to participate in said election being those who are authorized to participate in any General Election or Primary Election, caucus or convention, called or held by any political party for the nomination to said office pursuant to the general laws of the State of Alabama.
- 3. Subsequent to the adoption of this resolution, the Shelby County Commission will submit the District Plan for preclearance under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act, 42 U.S.C. sec. 1973c. All provisions of Resolution No. 92-01-13-13 which are not specifically inconsistent with the terms and provisions of this resolution shall remain in full force and effect.
- 4. Upon passage of this resolution, the Shelby County Commission shall file with the Judge of Probate of Shelby County a certified copy of this resolution, together with a map of Shelby County showing the boundaries of the revised districts.
