KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO/100's DOLLARS (\$232,000.00) to the undersigned grantor, ANDERSON HOMES, INC., a corporation, (herein referred to as GRANTOR), in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt of whereof is acknowledged, the said GRANTOR does by these presents grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto CHARLES RANDALL DEBERRY and KIMBERLY GREENE DEBERRY (herein referred to as GRANTEES) as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, the following described real estate, situated in SHELBY County, Alabama:

Lot 1, according to the Survey of River Highlands, as recorded in Map Book 19, Page 111, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Subject to:


