ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TKM COMMUNICATIONS, INC.


The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Alabama Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is TKM Communications, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

- (e) To purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in and with, shares or other interests in, or obligations of, corporations, associations, partnerships, individuals, or direct or indirect obligations of governmental entities or of any instrumentality thereof.
- (f) To lend money, invest and reinvest its funds, and take and hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned or invested; and,



(g) To transact any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Alabama Business Corporation Act.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is One Hundred (100) shares of common stock of the par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.
