AMENDED DECREE

This cause coming on to be heard, based upon the Plaintiff's Complaint, Answer and Counterclaim of the Defendant, testimony of the Defendant taken in open court as well as the absence of the Plaintiff, the Court finds as follows:

The parties hereto are husband and wife, having been such since August, 1984. There have been two (2) minor children born of the parties and the parties should be divorced on the grounds of incompatibility and irretrievable breakdown. It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

1. That the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Plaintiff and Defendant be, and the same are, hereby dissolved and the said CAROL ANN BRUNO is forever divorced from the said LLEUIELLYN BRUNO for and on the count of incompatibility and irretrievable breakdown.
2. That the Plaintiff and Defendant may again contract marriage as provided by law in this State, but not until sixty (60) days after the date of this judgment of divorce except to each other. Should this judgment be appealed from within forty-two (42) days the privilege hereby afforded the Plaintiff and Defendant to again contract marriage shall be held and remain in abeyance pending and abiding the results of such appeal. That there are no restrictions or

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prohibitions of remarriage of the parties granted herein to each other.

3. The Defendant is awarded custody of the minor children of the parties with the Plaintiff given visitation rights as follows:

A. Times, places and conditions which are mutually agreeable between the parties.

4. The Plaintiff will pay to the Defendant the sum of \$176.00 per month as support and maintenance for the minor children. Said payments are to be made through the Office of the Register in Chancery, P.O. Box 432, Talladega, Alabama 35161. Said payments shall begin on June 1, 1993.

5. The Defendant is awarded all right, title and interest of the marital home located on Highway 231 in Harpersville. The Defendant shall assume financial responsibility for said home. The Plaintiff is hereby divested of all his right, title and interest in the real property located on Highway 231 in Harpersville, Alabama. The Defendant is hereby invested with all right, title and interest in the real property located on Highway 231 in Harpersville, Alabama. The real property more particularly described as follows:

the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

SW 1/4, NW 1/4, Section 27, Township 19 South, Range 2 East, Commence at the Southeast corner of the above said quarter-quarter section and in a westerly direction along the south line of said quarter-quarter, run a distance of 1038.52 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue along the same said course for a distance of 195.67 feet; thence turn an angle of 90° to the right for a distance of 76.66 feet; thence turn an angle of 90° to the right for a distance of 195.67 feet; thence turn an angle of 90° to the right for a distance of 76.66 feet to the point of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to said GRANTEE forever.


6. The Defendant is awarded all of the household furnishings.

7. The Defendant is awarded the sum of \$225.00 as reimbursement for the stereo and vacuum cleaner.

8. The Plaintiff shall be responsible for the debt to Green Tree Acceptance.

9. Neither party hereafter shall act in such a manner as to harass, intimidate or humiliate the other party.
