# ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF SOUTHERN FAMILY HEALTH, LLC

The undersigned hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the provisions of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (the "Act"):

#### ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the limited liability company, referred to in these Articles as the "Company," is "Southern Family Health, LLC."

# ARTICLE II DURATION

The period of duration of the Company is fifty (50) years, beginning on the date these Articles of Organization are dated, unless sooner dissolved.

#### ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purposes for which the Company is organized are to own and operate one or more medical or health services clinics and to conduct such other lawful business for which limited liability companies may be organized under the Act and as may be specifically authorized by the members.

# ARTICLE IV REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE

The name of the Company's initial registered agent in Alabama is Jackie Frederick. The address and location of the Company's registered office in Alabama and the address of the said agent is 110 Indian Forest Trail, Pelham, Alabama 35124.

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#### ARTICLE V INITIAL MEMBERS

The names and mailing addresses of the initial members of the Company are:

### ARTICLE VI NEW MEMBERS

The members shall have the right to admit additional members upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Operating Agreement. A member shall not have the right to transfer her rights to be a member, except as set forth in the Operating Agreement, although a member shall have the rights of assignment of financial rights as provided and limited by the Act.

# ARTICLE VII DISSOLUTION

The circumstances under which the cessation of membership in the Company of one or more members will result in dissolution of the Company are set forth in the Operating Agreement.

# ARTICLE VIII MANAGEMENT

In accordance with the provisions of the Act, management of the Company is vested in its members.

# ARTICLE IX MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS

The Company shall have all of the powers of a limited liability company that are set out in the Act. The members have executed an Operating Agreement which shall govern the operation of the Company.

The Company shall be treated as a partnership for purposes of federal and state income tax purposes and for other State of Alabama Department of Revenue applications.
