

DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT, THAT I, **THOMAS L. WEBSTER**, OF 230 Crest Lake Drive, Birmingham, the State of Alabama, do hereby appoint **NEDRA W. WEBSTER**, of 230 Crest Lake Drive, Birmingham, the State of Alabama, my true and lawful attorney in fact, for me and in my name, place and stead, and for my use and benefit to:

1. To take, hold, possess, invest, lease, sell, or otherwise manage any or all of our real, personal or mixed property; to maintain, protect, preserve, remove, rebuild, modify, or improve the same or any part thereof:
2. To ask, demand, sue for, collect, and receive all sums of money, debts, or other obligations of any kind whatsoever which are now or shall hereafter become due, owing, or payable, or otherwise belong to me, to settle and compromise any such debts or obligations that may be due me and to endorse in my name any check or note payable to me or my order given in payment of any such debt or obligation and to take such other steps in connection with any such debt or obligation that she may deem necessary and proper and in my name to execute and deliver any receipts, releases, or discharges of any such debt or obligation with the same effect as if such receipts, releases, or discharges were executed by me personally.
3. To sell and to enter into a contract or contracts for the sale of all or part of my personal property, effects, and belongings of every kind and nature wherever situated, with full power to deliver possession of the personal property and to execute in my name any documents necessary to transfer title to the personal property including bills of sale or other documents of title, and to take any security interest for any unpaid balance which my attorney in fact, in her discretion may deem necessary and proper.
4. To give instructions for transactions and other necessary actions, withdraw funds or securities from any bank accounts at any time.
5. To inquire, give instructions and transact all business with reference to health insurance, ie: Medicare/Blue Cross-Blue Shield C-Plus, any HMO, as well as all business with Social Security, along with all personal business transactions.
