Right To Contest. Notice of Construction. PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

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Maintenance of insurance. Grantor shall produce and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements of a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all Improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsulance clause, and with a standard mortgagee clause in favor of Lender. Grantor shall also produce and maintain comprehensive general liability insurance in such coverage amounts as Lender may request with Lender being named as additional insurance in such liability insurance policies. Additionally, Grantor shall maintain such other insurance, including but not limited to hazard business interruption and boiler insurance as Lander may require. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. the Note or the Related Documents is false or misleading in any meterial respect, either now or at the time made or to have do to be in full force and effect (including failure of any Defective Collegeralization. This Mortgage or any of the Related Documents ceases to be in full force and effect (including failure of any

collateral documents to create a validand perfected sejurity interest or lien) at any time and for any reason insolvency. The dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business, the insolvency of Grantor, the appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, any type of creditor workout, or the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy; or insolvency laws by or against Grantor.

Foreclosure, Forfeiture, etc. Commencement of foreclosure or forfeiture proceedings, whether by judicial proceeding self-heig repossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor or by any governmental agency against alty of the Property.
