

# Articles of Incorporation of Strategic Communications, Inc.

**KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS**, that Strategic Communications, desiring to establish a business corporation dedicated to Bible exposition and publishing books, manuals, and other publications directed toward Bible study and youth ministry; and desirous of becoming incorporated under the laws of the State of Alabama, does hereby initiate these Articles of Incorporation according to the provisions of the Alabama Business Corporation Act.

## Article 1: Name

- § 1.01 The name of the Corporation shall be Strategic Communications, Inc.

## Article 2: Purposes

- § 2.01 The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are strictly within the bounds of State and Federal requirements for business corporations. Strategic Communications, Inc., shall establish a ministry of itinerant Bible preaching, exposition and publication of materials directed to youth in the effort to win them to Christ; and shall undertake any all legal activities permitted by the Alabama Business Corporation Act.
- § 2.02 This corporation reserves the right to exercise and pursue any and all powers prescribed for business corporations by the Alabama Business Corporation Act.

## Article 3: Duration

- § 3.01 The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual, unless sooner dissolved in accordance with the Laws of the State of Alabama pertaining to the dissolution of business corporations.

## Article 4: Capitalization and Shares of Stock

- § 4.01 The aggregate number of shares which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is 100 shares of common stock with a par value of \$10 each, for a total of \$1,000 in par value.
- § 4.02 There shall be only one class, common, which stock and ownership thereof shall be subject to the corporate bylaws and the restrictions on transfer of stock noted on said stock certificates.

### Article 5: Directors

§ 5.01 The number of voting directors shall be two, and they shall govern the affairs and business of the corporation.

§ 5.02 The number of initial Directors shall be four (4), and are listed herewith as follows:

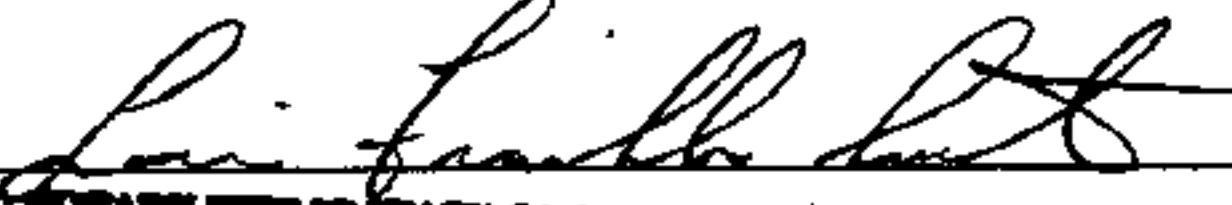
