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# ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION OF ELKINS ENTERPRISES, L.L.C., A LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY

Pursuant to Section 10-12-37, <u>Code Of Alabama</u>, 1975, as last amended, the undersigned hereby adopt the following Articles of Dissolution to dissolve forever that certain limited liability company known as Elkins Enterprises, L.L.C.

#### ARTICLE I.

1. That the name of the limited liability company to be dissolved is Elkins Enterprises, L.L.C.

#### ARTICLE II.

2. That Elkins Enterprises, L.L.C. was formed on September 30<sup>th</sup>, 1999, by Kenneth W. Elkins and Bryan A. Elkins.

#### ARTICLE III.

That the purpose of said association was for the general purpose of operating a liquor store and such other, further and different purpose as stated in the Articles of Organization or allowed under Alabama Limited Liability Act.

#### ARTICLE IV.

4. That the Articles of Organization of Elkins Enterprises, L.L.C. were filed in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama on September 30<sup>th</sup>, 1999 and recorded as instrument # 1999-40736.

#### ARTICLE V.

That all creditors of Elkins Enterprises, L.L.C. have been paid and there are not any debts outstanding at this time for which Elkins Enterprises, L.L.C. is liable and/or where its members Kenneth W. Elkins and Bryan A. Elkins are liable, due to their association through Elkins Enterprises, L.L.C.

#### ARTICLE VI.

That all property which may have been owned by Elkins Enterprises, L.L.C. has been properly divided and transferred to its members, Kenneth W. Elkins and Bryan A. Elkins.

## ARTICLE VII.

7. That all the business of Elkins Enterprises, L.L.C., as specified in its operating agreement, has been concluded and there is not any reason to preserve the business to prosecute and defend actions and proceedings, whether civil, criminal or administrative; nor to settle and close the limited liability company's business; nor to distribute the assets of the limited liability company pursuant to law; nor to perform any other necessary and/or appropriate act whatsoever.

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## ARTICLE VIII.

8. That the effective date of these Articles of Dissolution shall be on the date said articles are filed for record in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

## ARTICLE IX.

That there are no known claims for which Elkins Enterprises, L.L.C. is liable, nor are there any known claims for which its members, Kenneth W. Elkins and Bryan A. Elkins are liable as a result of being members of Elkins Enterprises, L.L.C.
