PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE ALABAMA BUSINESS CORPORATION ACT, THE UNDERSIGNED FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION SUBMITS THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION.

- Article I* The name of the corporation:
Clark Control Systems, Inc.
- Article II* The dissolution was authorized on January 4th, 2001.
- Article III* The total number of shareholder votes entitled to be cast is 100. The number of shareholder votes for the dissolution was 100 and the number of shareholder votes against the dissolution was 0.
- Article IV* If voting by groups, the information required by *Article III* above must be separately provided for each group entitled to vote. Not applicable.
- Article V* If the dissolution was approved by written consent of all shareholders, a statement to that effect may be substituted for requirements in *Articles III & IV* above when a copy of such signed consent is attached. Attached hereto as Attachment 1 is a true and correct copy of an action by written consent of the sole shareholder of the Company.
