NOW, THEREFORE in order to enhance and protect the value, attractiveness and desirability of the Property for the benefit of the Owners, Lessees, and other persons, the Association hereby amends The Oaks Covenants to include the following covenant, to run with the land.

4.1 Architectural Committee Membership. The Architectural Committee shall consist of seven (7) members and shall be the same seven (7) members who are elected to serve as the Association's Board of Directors. The terms to be served by said members shall be consistent with the terms of the Board of Directors as set out in the By Laws of the Association. Any member of the Architectural Committee must be an Association member in good standing. The Chairperson of the Architectural Committee shall be a member of the Board of Directors and shall be designated to serve in this position by the Board of Directors. Neither the members of the Architectural Committee nor its designated representatives shall be entitled to any compensation for services performed pursuant to these provisions.

The members of the Association may change the membership of the Architectural Committee through the process of electing new Directors, in accordance with the By Laws of the Association.
